Greg Cairnduff is from Hobart Tasmania. He is a graduate of the University of Tasmania and hold an M Ed, BA and Dip Ed from that university.



Greg has spent over 40 years in the teaching profession at first as a high school teacher of English and Studies of Society. He has had a long period in leadership positions as a high school Principal of several schools in Tasmania. He was also Executive Director of the Tasmanian Principals Institute, which was an Institute that provided Professional Learning for school leaders. In this role, he led many projects on behalf of the Australian Government working with the Royal Thai Ministry of Education related to school self-management and Leadership of schools.

He finished his career in Australia working in the Faculty of Education at the University of Tasmania as a lecturer and as Director of the Bachelor of Education degree.

Greg is the Director of the Australian International School of Bangkok which has campuses in Sukhumvit Soi 20 and Sukhumvit Soi 31 and also at RamInthra.

This school is a small but rapidly growing on one which currently has over 400 students and 40 expatriate teachers. The school is on a pathway to providing international school education from Nursery to Year 13, using the Australian Curriculum.
